The 2021 WOGA Classic and Liukin Invitational will bring together thousands of competitors in Women's and Men's Artistic Gymnastics, and Acrobatics.

COVID-19 SAFETY GUIDELINES

Ford Center has implemented a series of health / sanitation policies and procedures and are following guidelines from the CDC, NFL, State of Texas, and local public safety / health officials.

FACE COVERINGS / MASKS

All fans and stadium employees will be required to wear a mask at all times except when they are actively eating or drinking unless they are under the age of ten.

SEATING & CAPACITY

Capacity at Ford Center will be limited. Fans are required to practice social distancing inside and outside of Ford Center, including parking lots, entrance queues and seating. Seats will be grouped together in "pods" so that distance can be maintained between groups who are not known to one another. Fans should only sit in a "pod" with their family, friends or trusted group. Seats that are open for this event will be marked with a white sticker showing a checkmark and seats that are to remain closed will be zip tied shut.

SANITIZATION POLICY

Ford Center will be following guidelines from the CDC and local health officials to put a thorough cleaning and disinfecting plan in place using EPA registered products. Between each gym session, guests will be asked to leave the seating bowl so that each seat can be sanitized and prepared for the following session to begin.

MOBILE TICKETING

All tickets at Ford Center will be digital and available through fans' mobile devices.

LOST & FOUND

If you have lost an item at any point during the event or find an item you would like to turn in, report to our Guest Services Center which is located behind section 127.

WI-FI

Ford Center provides free wi-fi services for all of its guests. Connect to TheStarWifi in your list of available wi-fi networks. When prompted with the web page, click the checkbox that you agree to the Terms and Conditions of Service and then click connect.

ADA/ACCESSIBILITY

Ford Center is committed to serving guests with disabilities. Our facilities are fully accessible, and we provide a wide range of services and amenities for guests with special needs. Guests can receive more information by visiting one of our Guest Services Center located on the concourse behind Section 127. Animals are not permitted in Ford Center with the exception of service animals and service animals in training. For more information, please contact the Guest Services Hotline at (972) 497-4800.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Bags, purses, outside alcohol, food items*, bottles, cans and beverage containers of any kind*, coolers*, weapons of any kind, laser pointers, footballs, signs or flags on sticks, noisemakers, tripods, monopods and cameras with lens larger than 3" (detachable or non-detachable), video cameras, chairs, stools or other seating devices. *Exceptions will be made for Guests with special medical needs.

SECURITY SCREENING

All guests entering Ford Center are subject to a physical security screening of their person and accompanying items. The physical screening consists of a hand-held metal detector sweep across the entire body. Guests who wish not to be screened by metal detector may elect a physical pat-down screening as an alternative. All other articles will be visually inspected. Items in sealed/wrapped boxes must be opened for inspection.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Ford Center Management is committed to creating a safe, comfortable and enjoyable experience for our guests. Our staff will proactively support an environment free from the following behaviors: Abusive, foul or disruptive language and obscene gestures, intoxication or other signs of impairment related to alcohol consumption, fighting, taunting or threatening remarks or gestures, sitting in a location other than the guest's ticketed seat, displays of affection not appropriate in a public setting, obscene or indecent clothing, any disruption to the progress of the event by the guest's actions.

FORD CENTER BAG POLICY IN EFFECT

The Ford Center Bag Policy is in effect for this game. Ford Center instituted the National Football League's policy that limits the size and types of bags entering Ford Center on event days. The policy is a league-wide initiative intended to enhance public safety for events at NFL stadiums across the country. The NFL strongly encourages fans to not bring any type of bags to the venue. However, should bags be needed, approved items include:

- Clear plastic, vinyl or PVC totes that do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"
- Clear one-gallon re-sealable storage bags
- Small clutch purses/bags approximately the size of a hand – not to exceed 4.5" x 6.5" in size – with or without a handle or strap

Prohibited bags include, but are not limited to: purses larger than a clutch bag, coolers, briefcases, backpacks, fanny packs, cinch bags, seat cushions, luggage of any kind, computer bags and camera bags or any bag larger than the permissible size. FORD CENTER BAG POLICY
SMALLER CLUTCH SIZE
NO PURSES. CLEAR BAGS ONLY.

In an effort to enhance public safety, Ford Center has modified its security policy by limiting the size and style of bags allowed in the venue.

APPROVED BAGS

CLEAR TOTE
Plastic, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"

PLASTIC STORAGE BAG
Clear, one (1) gallon, re-sealable

SMALLER CLUTCH SIZE
Approximately the size of a hand with or without a handle or strap. No larger than 4.5" x 6.5" with or without a handle or strap. Can be carried separately or within an approved plastic bag.

PROHIBITED BAGS

PROHIBITED ITEMS INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- All purses, bags or containers larger than a small clutch bag
- Backpacks
- Binocular case
Binoculars may be worn around the neck.
- Briefcases
- Camera bags
- Cinch bags
- Computer bags
- Coolers
- Diaper bags
- Fanny packs
- Luggage of any kind
- Seat Cushions

An exception will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection at a gate designated for this purpose. Please limit the number of items you bring to the stadium on event days.
