Based in Indianapolis, the organization is committed to creating a culture that empowers and supports its athletes and focuses on its highest priority, the safety and well-being of the athletes.

LOST & FOUND

MOBILE TICKETS

We will be using only mobile tickets for this event. Please confirm that you have those tickets ready before attempting to enter the facility.

RE-ENTRY IS NOT PERMITTED

Once guests exit the building they must purchase another ticket if they wish to reenter.

ALL SESSION PASS

All guests will be asked to leave the facility between sessions including all session pass holders. We will need to reset the building prior to opening the doors again for entrance.

MERCHANDISE

Expected to be sold on the Concourse around the corner from the main entrance to the facility.

BAG POLICY

Ford Center Bag Policy is in effect for this event. Ford Center has instituted a policy that limits the size and types of purses and bags entering Ford Center on event days for all events. Ford Center strongly encourages fans to not bring any type of bags to the venue.

ADA/ACCESSIBILITY

Ford Center is committed to serving guests with disabilities. Our facilities are fully accessible and we provide a wide range of services and amenities for guests with special needs. Guests can receive more information by visiting one of our Guest Services Center located on the concourse behind Section 127. Animals are not permitted in Ford Center with the exception of service animals and service animals in training. For more information, please contact the Guest Services Hotline at (972) 497-4800.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Bags, purses, outside alcohol, food items*, bottles, cans and beverage containers of any kind*, coolers*, weapons of any kind, laser pointers, footballs, signs or flags on sticks, noisemakers, tripods, monopods and cameras with lens larger than 3" (detachable or non-detachable), video cameras, chairs, stools or other seating devices.
*Exceptions will be made for Guests with special medical needs.

SECURITY SCREENING

All guests entering Ford Center are subject to a physical security screening of their person and accompanying items. The physical screening consists of a walkthrough metal detector. Guests who wish not to be screened by metal detector may elect a physical pat-down screening as an alternative. All other articles will be visually inspected. Items in sealed/wrapped boxes must be opened for inspection.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Ford Center Management is committed to creating a safe, comfortable and enjoyable experience for our guests. Our staff will proactively support an environment free from the following behaviors: Abusive, foul or disruptive language and obscene gestures, intoxication or other signs of impairment related to alcohol consumption, fighting, taunting or threatening remarks or gestures, sitting in a location other than the guest's ticketed seat, displays of affection not appropriate in a public setting, obscene or indecent clothing, any disruption to the progress of the event by the guest's actions.

FORD CENTER BAG POLICY IN EFFECT

The Ford Center Bag Policy is in effect for this event. Ford Center instituted the National Football League's policy that limits the size and types of bags entering Ford Center on event days. The policy is a league-wide initiative intended to enhance public safety for events at NFL stadiums across the country. The NFL strongly encourages fans to not bring any type of bags to the venue. However, should bags be needed, approved items include:

- Clear plastic, vinyl or PVC totes that do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"
- Clear one-gallon re-sealable storage bags
- Small clutch purses/bags approximately the size of a hand – not to exceed 4.5" x 6.5" in size – with or without a handle or strap

Prohibited bags include, but are not limited to: purses larger than a clutch bag, coolers, briefcases, backpacks, fanny packs, cinch bags, seat cushions, luggage of any kind, computer bags and camera bags or any bag larger than the permissible size. FORD CENTER BAG POLICY

NO PURSES. CLEAR BAGS ONLY.

In an effort to enhance public safety, Ford Center has modified its security policy by limiting the size and style of bags allowed in the venue.

APPROVED BAGS

CLEAR TOTE
Plastic, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"



PLASTIC STORAGE BAG
Clear, one (1) gallon, re-sealable



Approximately the size of a hand with or without a handle or strap. No larger than 4.5" x 6.5" with or without a handle or strap. Can be carried separately or within an approved plastic bag.

PROHIBITED BAGS

PROHIBITED ITEMS INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- All purses, bags or containers larger than a small clutch bag
- Backpacks
- Binocular case
Binoculars may be worn around the neck.
- Briefcases
- Camera bags
- Clutch bags
- Computer bags
- Coolers
- Diaper bags
- Fanny packs
- Luggage of any kind
- Seat Cushions











An exception will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection at a gate designated for this purpose. Please limit the number of items you bring to the stadium on event days.
